→10:00 a.m. – noon – Citizens Water Advocacy Group Meeting - Retired USGS hydrologist Bill Meyer will give a talk entitled "Estimating the Hydrologic Consequences of Ground Water Development in Big Chino Valley - He will focus on what we know about the Big Chino Valley Ground Water System at the present time, including the ultimate impact of existing and proposed ground water withdrawal in the Valley on the flow of the upper Verde River - He will also discuss previous models constructed by the USBR and Southwest Groundwater Consultants and the existing efforts of the USGS - The various models have been at issue in the appeal of the ruling by the Arizona

Department of Water Resources on Prescott's application for a modification of the City's Assured Water Supply designation. Prescott Mayor Jack Wilson has disputed the USBR model validity.
